Factory-default reset, available only with firmware version 7.9.1 on AirPort Time Capsule 802.11ac and AirPort Extreme 802.11ac: Disconnect the base station from power. While holding down the reset button, connect the base station to power and continue to hold the reset button for about 6 seconds, until the status light on the base station flashes amber rapidly.

Connect an Ethernet cable that you know is working from one of the LAN <--> Ethernet ports on your network router to the WAN "0" port on the AirPort Express. Power up the Express for a few minutes, then hold in the reset button on the back of the Express for 7-8 seconds, then release the reset button and allow a full minute for the AirPort Express to restart to a slow, blinking amber light status.
